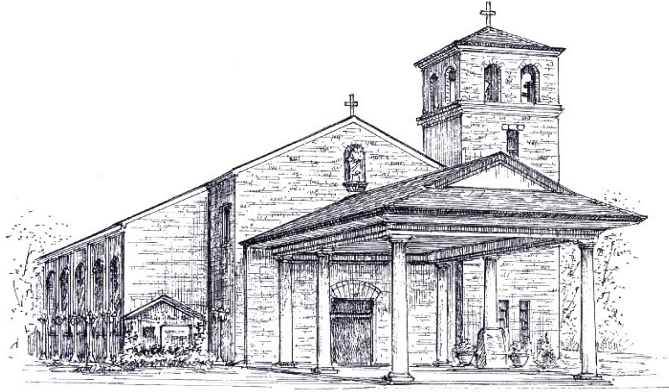

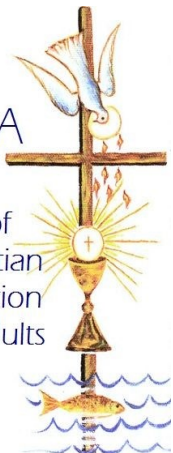
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

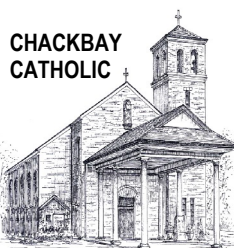
