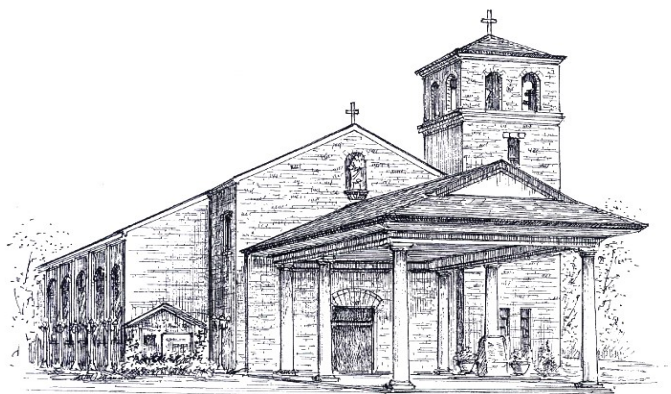

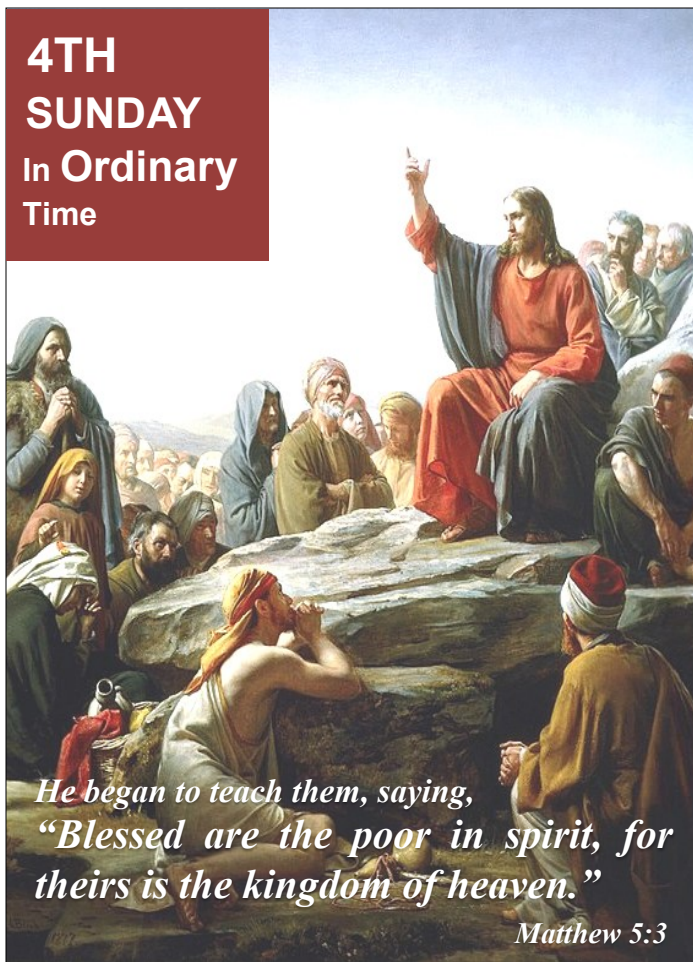

SAINT BLAISE

Pray For Us



Friday, February 3, 2023 Feast of Saint Blaise

St. Blaise was a bishop in Armenia who was martyred during the fourth century. According to tradition, a mother, whose son was choking on a fishbone, approached good Bishop Blaise for assistance. St. Blaise blessed the boy and he was able to cough up the bone. For this reason the Church celebrates his feast with a blessing of throats. The priest or deacon holds two blessed candles and touches them to the neck of each person. He recites a short blessing and prays that the person may be healed especially of any throat infections or illnesses.

The blessing of throats will take place after all Masses the weekend of Feb. 4 - 5.
